JOB DESCRIPTION

The Food Plater/Prep Cook receives orders from our menu of small plates, dishes and desserts and plates prepared foods and ingredients based on the chef's guidance and specifications.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Reporting to the Bar Manager or Food & Beverage Director, responsibilities and essential job functions include, but are not limited to:

- Assembling food orders to completion;
- Practicing speedy service;
- Reading and following a prep Sheet;
- Staying organized and stocked;
- Meeting and maintaining all food and plate specifications;
- Meeting established cook/warming-time standards when necessary;
- Assisting with stocking and setting up the kitchen/plating station;
- Working with servers and bartenders to ensure that orders are completed according to request and on time;
- Washing and cleaning the kitchen. plates, utensils, and cooking wares and storing the equipment during and at the end of service;
- Assisting servers with running/delivering food orders to customers as needed;
- Ensuring that the kitchen operation procedures and hygiene meet food safety standards and regulations;

REQUIREMENTS

The individual must possess the following knowledge, skills and abilities and be able to explain and demonstrate that he or she can perform the essential functions of the job, with or without reasonable accommodation, using some other combination of knowledge, skills, and abilities:

- Must be able to speak, read, write and understand the primary language(s) used in the workplace;
- Must be able to read and write to facilitate the communication process;
- Requires good communication skills, both verbal and written;
- Must possess basic computational ability;
- Most work tasks are performed indoors. Temperature is moderate and controlled by hotel environmental systems;
- Must be able to stand and exert well-paced mobility for up to 8 hours in length;
- Must be able to lift up to 50 lbs. on an occasional basis;
- Must be able to push and pull carts and equipment weighing up to 250 lbs. on an occasional basis;
- Must be able to bend, stoop, kneel, squat and stretch to fulfill cleaning and stocking tasks;
- Must be able to exert well-paced ability to reach different floors of the hotel on a timely basis;
- Requires grasping, writing, typing, standing, sitting, walking, repetitive motions, bending, climbing, listening

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and hearing ability and visual acuity;

- Talking and hearing occur continuously in the process of communicating with guests, supervisors and other employees;
- Vision occurs continuously with the most common visual functions being those of near vision and depth perception;
- Requires manual dexterity to use and operate all necessary equipment;

QUALIFICATION STANDARDS

- Minimum 1-year experience working within the hospitality industry preferred but not required;
- TIPS and Serv-Safe Certifications preferred but not required;
- Previous point of sale system experience a plus;
- Excellent communication and organizational skills;
- Ability to work well under pressure in a fast paced environment;
- Ability to work cohesively with fellow colleagues as part of a team;
- Ability to focus attention on guest needs, remaining calm and courteous at all times.
